Pioneers Announce \$5,000 in Scholarships

Pioneers began accepting scholarship applications for the 2010-2011 academic year on November 15th. Five \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded.

Eligibility requirements include:

The student must be a relative of a Pioneers member (Regular, Life, Associate or Honorary as defined by the Pioneers bylaws) but need not be a dependent or nor live in the same residence with the Pioneers member.

The student must be a high school senior planning to enter an accredited post-secondary institution or trade school upon graduation from high school.

Applicants must have a minimum grade point average of 2.50 on a 4.0 grade scale, 3.1 on a 5.0 grade scale or at least a cumulative numerical grade of 80 out of 100 or better in all academic courses.

Scholarships are awarded based on applicant

involvement in community service, school and leadership activities and academic achievement. All applications are judged by an outside independent scholarship judging organization.

Eligible students must complete the scholarship application form and submit all the requested certifying documentation including a certified copy of the most current high school cumulative grade transcript.

Applications will be accepted November 15, 2010 through February 28, 2011 (postmark deadline.)

Pioneers Bring Joy Over the Holidays

Now that the holiday season is in full swing, Pioneers are more visible than ever bringing joy and hope to their communities. At this time of year many people are in dire need of any assistance being offered.

For instance, many families' bread-winners have lost their jobs and may not be able to afford food or clothes, let alone holiday gifts this winter. Pioneers answer the call of those in need for cold weather clothing by participating in coat drives and knitting scarves, hats and mittens. To help the food insecure, Pioneers Units collect food and donate it to local food banks, serve in soup kitchens, donate full Thanksgiving dinners and deliver food for Meals on Wheels.

The Auraria Council of the Qwest Pioneers in Denver has provided Christmas Stockings to needy children in the Denver metro area for over 30 years. Each year, Pioneers cut and sew the stockings and Pioneers, family and friends are asked to decorate and fill them for children ages 0 - 17. This year, the council teamed up with the Pioneers Headquarters and hosted two Christmas Stocking Open Houses which invited Qwest employees to decorate and fill a stocking for a needy child and sign up to be a Pioneer member. The Pioneers International Board of Directors also participated in decorating and filling stockings at the December Face to Face in Denver.
